Honduras Highlights

December 2013



Honduras report from Dr. Teresa Seeing the kids is always a great joy. The hugs and kisses are rewarding.

- The kids are doing better. They were sick with flu the last two weeks.
- All the children will be going to the dentist. Our goal is to have five children a day visiting the dentist. This will cost us \$2000, so candy for them is questionable now. If you come, don't bring candy because it costs us money to give them candy. I know in America that amount might be for just one tooth, but for here, it is a lot of money.
- Antonio, who had club foot, was operated on in September. Thank you, Jesus. Pray for him to have a good recuperation.



• We have a newborn baby as part of the IMI family. Her name is Marion. She is a result of a rape. She is staying with her mom who is breastfeeding for at least a month so the baby gets all the nutrients she needs. Soon she will join the rest of the babies at the orphanage. Now we have to buy food and vitamins for the mom and clothes, milk, diapers and vitamins for the baby. Thank you, Jesus, she is healthy.

- In October, we had a team here from Hope Church in Le Claire, IA who helped build the basketball court. They also raised \$690 for a washer. Thank you Jesus and Hope Church for that. It is very much needed. I'm going shopping next week, yay!!
- We are about to pour the cement for the basketball court, but the rain stopped that from happening. Pray we have good weather so we can finish it.



- The roof on the hotel is done. Thank you, Lord. Pretty soon we will start with the interior. I went to see the tile and windows for it. This is exciting!
- The workers are finishing the walls and tile for the school. They are even working on Sunday, PTL.
- We also have a construction team from the Foursquare Church in Wyoming doing walls at the school and working on the medical clinic. They work very hard. Thank you, guys, you are awesome.
- Our missionaries, Lyn and Jim Moomey are moving to Honduras in a couple of days. We are so happy for them.
- We are taking the children to the amusement park today. It is not a big one, just a small park that came to town, charging \$2 a ticket. The children are all excited and happy.

Agriculture We now have three cows, a bull and many chickens. Also, we just sent \$1,500 to plant over 500 fruit trees. Please keep Pastor Oscar, our farmer/pastor, in prayer. He is doing a great job for Jesus. Our goal is to not only be self-sufficient as far as the food we are raising, but to begin to sell food to our neighbors. To donate to the farm, mark **farm** on your check.

IMI's new missionaries By the time you get this newsletter as of November 15th, Rev. Jim and Rev. Lyn Moomey will be back in Honduras. They were in a car accident, but God spared them. Please keep them in prayer. Our kids need a full-time mom and dad. And Jim can fix a lot of things. Praise God for our new partners.

IMI retail center The roof and entrance is finished. We are waiting on the bids to finish the inside of the building. We have \$71,000 ready to send for finishing the interior. We have decided to immediately put in ten hotel rooms and also have a restaurant and three stores (pharmacy, food and hardware). We believe we will need another \$30,000 to finish the hotel rooms and stores. This will help us become more self-sufficient.

Honduras mission building projects

School Slowly, but surely...everything is done but the tile. Our children are excited to move into their new air-conditioned school.

Thank you At our IMI Holy Ghost Fire Women's Conference the first weekend of November, we were able to raise \$4,000. Tom and I matched that number and now we have \$8,000. Thank you, ladies, for your generosity. The money will go for the following needs for the orphanage:

- Commercial refrigerator for kitchen \$1,800
- Commercial printer for the school \$800
- Eight white boards for the classrooms \$600
- 46 school desks for the children \$2400
- One keyboard for music classes \$300
- Drums for the worship team \$200
- Four beds \$450
- One heifer \$350

• \$1000 to help 24-year-old Johana, a poor lady from our church who was shot in the lower abdomen. She was pregnant and lost her baby. Her uterus, intestines and bladder were perforated, requiring an eight-hour operation. A few days after the operation, she got a very serious infection caused by *Pseudomonas Aeruginosa* bacteria. She could die from this infection if she didn't receive treatment immediately. Thanks to our generous ladies who raised \$1000 at the IMI conference, we were able to save her life. This treatment is very expensive. The name of the medication is Meropenem. For three days of treatment, we paid \$500. Today, I paid another \$500 for three more days. The City of Refuge is growing A third family is going to Honduras to build their house. Do you trust the government? Do you want a beautiful vacation home? Do you want a house fully paid off? Another crunch is coming – pray about building in Honduras. It's approximately \$30 a square foot.

Honduras construction projects accomplished so far in 2013

- We recently finished our brand new kitchen.
- Three bathrooms for our workers and missionaries are completed at our city.
- We finished a septic system.
- We set up over twelve to fifteen 40-foot electric poles.
- Our large boys orphanage is completed.
- We finished a two-bedroom house.
- We also finished a one-bedroom house.
- We built a huge shed for our building supplies.
- Sidewalks for our Honduras compound have been built.

Around the World

IMI is expanding rapidly – biggest expansion ever (adding 14 orphanages and 420 full orphans)

Just before we left to go to Liberia, Mercy Smiles – which is run by my spiritual mission parents, Norm and Karen Knudsen – have agreed to hand over their fourteen orphanages with over 420 children when they graduate to heaven. Despite going very strong, Norm and Karen are in their late 70's, and they feel the need to turn over the orphanages to IMI. How cool is this. Karen had a vision 35 years ago that I would go on a mission trip with her husband. 35 years ago this week, I went on my very first mission trip to Colombia. Despite my rebellious attitude that got me lost in the jungle and almost caused Norm and the other missionary to send me home early, God called me into the ministry. Now 35 years later to the week, "mother" Teresa and I agreed to take on the fourteen orphanages. This is the largest venture we have taken on since we first started. Norm and Karen have been in ministry for forty years and to have them hand over their ministry is not only a huge honor, but a humungous responsibility. Our budget just increased dramatically. Our ministry in Honduras has just been surpassed by our ministry in India. Please mark **India** on your check.

Liberia updates

1. Our pastor from the jungles of Liberia has begun preparing the land to grow food to sell so he can continue on in his ministry. This is a fulfillment of a prophecy that agriculture changes culture.

2. We have put a roof on our new church. This roof covers half of the building and we will be putting on the other half, hopefully, this month. It is a 6,000-square-foot church that is shaped like an L. This building will also be used as a business and as a school.

3. The orphanage property has been turned over to IMI. We now have twenty beautiful children. We are getting estimates to build a building for the children. Where they live now is horrible with bad drinking water and no walls, so people are walking right through their compound. The children have no protection, living in a dingy building with little space and light; plus, they don't have a cooking stove. Please pray about **Liberia** and send your offering.

4. We were given two acres with a functioning school and a church. Immediately after the deed was signed over. IMI bought 100 new desks for \$1,000 to bless our new students. With over 100 students, this is the largest IMI school in our network. We will be remodeling the school. If you want to donate to godly and Spirit-filled education mark **education** on your check.

5. Pastor Steve sent money to put a roof on our new church located in Liberia. This is our first building on our property in the City of Refuge Liberia.



Jeff and Maria Boyce are planning a mission trip to Maria's home country of Sierra Leone from Nov. 16th through Dec. 3rd. In 1999, Maria lost both of her hands to rebel soldiers in a brutal civil war. She has an amazing testimony of how she met Jesus and forgave the rebels. She now resides in the U.S. and will be traveling back to Sierra Leone for the first time. While there, Jeff and Maria plan on seeking out land for IMI to build an orphanage and assisting Maria's father, mother, and seven siblings with provision for a stable living situation. To

Bangladesh school update Our missionary to Bangladesh, Kris Palmer, is taking a team in February. They are looking forward to ministering to 120 children who are attending our Christian school amongst Hindus and Muslims. The children in Laudov are patiently waiting for their new building to be completed, which our team hopes to see as well. Pastor Lawrence has purchased the materials. There have been major rain delays, but one of the walls has been started. As soon as the rainy season is over, the school will be finished.

IMI hits the three million meals mark through September 30th Thanks to God and his people, IMI has paid shipping on 330,000 meals to the Philippines each of the last eight months. To help out, mark **food** on your offering check. Through the generous giving of IMI partners we were able to send a forty-foot container of food to the Philippines through our partner – Risen Savior Missions. Thanks for your support in feeding 6,000 children. We would like to be able to do this every month, if possible.

Construction projects in progress

- The walls around our medical clinic in Honduras are half-finished.
- Our eight-classroom school in Honduras is almost finished. Everything is done but the tile.
- The roof is finished on our retail center and hotel in Honduras.
- A roof is being built on one of our churches in Liberia. Half of the roof is finished.
- We are building a school in Bangladesh (20% completed) but paid for.
- We are building a gymnasium in the Philippines (25% completed)

LIBERIA REPORT BY PASTOR FREEMAN

The first picture is part of the twelve lots (three acres) that IMI purchased in Grand Gehere. The pastor and his congregation will no longer rent land to grow vegetables, they will be self-sufficient by growing and selling on IMI property. The property was surveyed, corner markers put in place and the deed is in IMI-Liberia's name. This is also the area where they can harvest wood. It would cost approximately \$2,000 USD to purchase a chain saw. When we were there, you set up a plan regarding percentages for paying laborers, re-investing for a new saw, etc. They are just waiting to move on that when you are ready. The other pictures are the school buildings and the church. You sent \$1,000 USD for school desks – \$500 purchased fifty desks, which are being made, and \$500 went toward windows and doors, which are also being made. The property and all the buildings have been deeded over to IMI-Liberia. We look forward to sending pictures of students and some information about them.

We could feel joy, peace and unity in that place. The anointing of God was very strong. The ladies got ministered to, some were healed, some were delivered, some received a prophetic word. We had powerful, anointed speakers. They blessed us so much with their messages. The food was fantastic! Thank you, Lyn and Jim Mommey for doing an amazing job in the kitchen. Thank you to the ladies who helped set up the conference and took care of details during the conference and those who helped with clean up and laundry. It was team work. I couldn't have done it without you. Thank you, ladies, for coming to the conference. Your giving raised \$4,000 which Tom and I matched making a total of \$8,000. 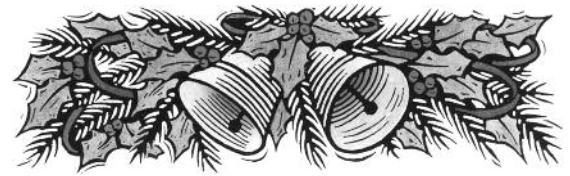
Teresa's medical bills and health
 Thank you so much to our friends who sent us money to cover my medical bills, which were \$5,000. Thank you, Jesus, that is covered. I want to clarify that last month's newsletter had a mistake about the total cost of the bills. Tom is so busy and I'm traveling in Honduras. Sometimes I miss checking before it is printed. When I read the last newsletter after it was sent out, I was so depressed because of the big numerical mistake in it about my medical bill. I cried almost the whole day, but there was nothing I could do to fix it. It was too late. Forgive us for not checking. I know Tom is so busy and sometimes doesn't check what he writes. From now on, I will be sure to double-check before is printed. For your information, we have a very high deductible insurance so we cannot afford to go to the doctor for everything. It is cheaper for me to fly to another country to have all my checkups done, including airfare. I was very concerned about a lump in my throat and dizziness. I needed to have an MRI done, which would be very expensive in America. Plus, I had to have some dental work done and an eye operation, which – thank you, Jesus – was successful. I went to Peru to take care of all of that and also have the opportunity to visit my family, which was very refreshing. My MRI was good. The doctor said that there was a chronic inflammation and it was nothing to worry about. Thank you, Jesus, for that. It was interesting that when I went to have a blood test done because I was feeling dizzy, they found out that my cholesterol and triglycerides were over 400 mg/dl. That is extremely high and was the reason for the dizziness. The doctor said I needed to go on a diet and take Lipitor. I started a very strict diet, along with working out. In eight weeks, I lowered my triglycerides to 185 mg/dl and cholesterol to 170/mg/dl. Thank you, Jesus. Now I'm eating lots of fruits and vegetables, and chicken and fish are my friends. Thank you for your loving and giving hearts.

Family news My son and my son-in-law are having their best financial years in my son's lawyer and my son-in-law's landscaping business. Praise God! And they give to our orphans, too. My second granddaughter is now in pre-school. And the oldest reads ten books a week. My youngest granddaughter has my eyes. 😊
