WISDOM FROM THE *Word* FULFILLING YOUR DESTINY – PART NINE

Ephesians 1:5-6 "In love he predestined us to be adopted as his sons in accordance to his pleasure and will."

His will... Why are people unhappy, unfulfilled and miserable? One of the reasons is because they are not doing His will. Jonah was swallowed by a whale for attempting to run from His call. David lost a child because of sin. David should have been fighting battles instead of watching live porn. Although serving God is extremely difficult, there is nothing like being in the center of His will. I have to admit it is stressful trying to raise the monies to feed 10,000 children, dig wells, pay medical bills, buy land, etc. It's challenging dealing with fickle pickles. Yet I have great joy in working with God and His people to bring the kingdom of God from heaven to earth. Are you in His will? Are you fulfilling God's purpose for your life? How do I know what His will is and if I am in it?

#1 The clearest and simplest way is to read the Bible and make sure you are obeying it. Do you know that I have never had a prophetic word about feeding orphans? I don't need one because God's Word tells me to do it. I don't need an angel to tell me to love my wife. I have His Word. Are you reading His Word? Are you meditating on it? And are you obeying it? As David said, "it truly is a lamp unto my feet."

#2 "In the multitude of counselors, there is safety" is a scripture

that I follow. When I am being tossed back and forth trying to make a decision, I talk to my wife and closest and wisest friends. I ask their godly opinion and try to see if there is a consensus. Take a minute and write down who your closest and wisest friends are. Take the time to call them and take notes of what they are saying, and you should start seeing a divine pattern.

#3 I pray, and then, I listen for the voice of God, and He will speak to me. Three years ago, the Lord told me to get involved in agriculture, and now, we are starting to see the results of our investment. I listened to Him when He told me to invest in small businesses with Christian brothers; one earned us 38% and the other earned us 50% on our money. Tell me what kind of legal investments can get that type of return.

#4 I find out what works. Jesus told us that it is to Father's glory to bear much fruit. If I am doing things that bear little or no fruit, then I know I am going the wrong direction. What works helps me determine what God's will is.

#5 Have sanctified desires. God gives you the desires of your heart, if your heart is pure and you truly want to please God. Is it your heart's desire to bless God and serve Him? If it is, you are probably in God's will.

In Colossians, Paul commands us to forbear one another, which means we need to overlook one another's faults. In marriage, it is easy to concentrate on the failings and weaknesses of our partner instead of walking in grace and forgiveness and appreciating each other.

I have found the most important one to please is God and also those people that we are partnering with. It's a waste of time trying to please people that you are not partnering with. Who are you trying to please that is a waste of time?

Honduras Highlights

Report from Dr. Theresa *Dr. Teresa is in Honduras for the first ten days of every month.* Currently, we are harvesting vegetables from our garden at the orphanage, and the nannies are so happy making meals with our own produce. The children are learning how to work by cleaning up the land and picking up rocks. This week, we are planting corn, and the kids are helping Jim and Jean.

As far as construction, we are installing commercial toilets so the kids won't wear them out. If we install regular toilets, they don't last long. Pray that this time the toilets be easier to maintain. We also started to build a 6,000 square-foot school last week!! They are measuring and starting to make the footings. It is going to have twelve classrooms. Praise the Lord. Also, we have half of the fencing of the medical clinic done, and the two gates are done.

The children are having church services every morning before school. They are starting to get on-fire for Jesus as they learn to seek God. All of the children are learning rapidly because God has given us a principal and a good staff of teachers to help the children learn better. The children are learning to make donuts and bread in their cooking classes. They are going to start making bread to sell at the church.

Last month, we bought a \$10,000 18-horsepower pump, with irrigation tubes, that is one of the best on the market. Our land needs to be watered six months a year, so now will be able to irrigate the whole farm in no time. Thanks be to God who is our provider. Now, we are having the irrigation lines set up professionally. We have an engineer working on that, under the supervision of a prominent irrigation expert who is donating his time.

New bathrooms built The tile work in our new bathrooms is finished, and we just picked up new commercial toilets. We have over forty different employees who work at our orphanage/town that have no access to bathrooms, and when we bring our missionaries for the day, there are no lavatories for them. But thanks be to God, we are building three bathrooms (one for male workers, one for female workers, one for missionaries) and a shower.

The City of Refuge is growing Another family is building a house in Honduras. Do you trust the government? Do you want a beautiful vacation home? Do you want a house fully paid off? Another crunch is coming – pray about building in Honduras. It's approximately \$20 a square foot.

Ag report from Hermansons in Honduras We are planting the corn! We will be finished by midweek. Thanks to Pastor Oscar and our children here, we harvested the beans over the weekend and have readied that area for corn. We are in the rainy season now, and the beans don't require much water. We will plant a new crop of beans in September to replace the corn when it is harvested.

The new cabbage, broccoli and cauliflower seedlings went in the ground last week. The watermelon, cantaloupe, zucchini and squash plants are absolutely covered in blossoms! We have a few cantaloupe ready to be picked. We are harvesting the cucumbers, radishes, etc. as they develop, and we can't believe how excited the nannies got over the radishes. We are starting the peppers and tomatoes over in a new area because they got hit by blight, or what some people here call "the plague". Fortunately, the pepper and tomato seedlings are ready to be put in the ground. I love God's timing!

We have 210 fruit trees in the ground which are doing well. Our goal is to have 400 more by end of the month. Sorry for no photos. I know you enjoy them, but our camera has died. We are saving up to order a new one soon.

Honduras

Our goal in one year is to have all of the food supply for our orphanage and church members to be met and to have enough to sell to the community. We have 36 kinds of fruits, vegetables, grains and meat to raise. Each month we want to knock off three of these, so that in one year we will be growing everything needed to meet our increasing expenses.

Plant a tree and multiply your giving

A five-dollar tree can produce hundreds or more pieces of fruit each year.

If a tree produces for ten years, your five dollars will be multiplied to \$1,000. We can purchase 22 trees per every hundred dollars donated.

For a minimum of a hundred dollars, we will put a sign of your favorite person there.



IMI's new missionaries Jim and Lyn Moomey, from the Milwaukee area, will be joining the staff of our Honduras orphanage. Jim will oversee the new water purification plant that will be installed in June. Lyn and Jim will also assist with the general operation of the orphanage. They have an interest in teaching the older orphans job skills, as well as developing profit-making projects that will help sustain the orphanage financially. Lyn and Jim will start their fundraising campaign in June. They are anticipating a one-week trip to the orphanage in early September. They will return for one month to work with Tom and Teresa in the United States. In October, they plan to permanently make their home in Honduras. The Moomey's have two children – Hannah, 21, and David, 18.

First time ever IMI gives away over \$100,000 in one month Impact Ministries International was able to give away over \$100,000 in one month. It has been on my heart to do that for many years. IMI pays shipping on 330,000 meals to the Philippines each of the last three months Through the generous giving of IMI partners, we were able to send a forty-foot container of food to the Philippines through our partner – Risen Savior Missions. Thanks for your support in feeding 6,000 children. We would like to be able to do this every month, if possible.

From Dayspring and Impact Children's Home in Andhra Pradesh, India, recently sponsored by IMI As we entered the home of Dayspring and Impact Children's Home, we were greeted by seventy very happy smiling faces. They were so excited as we hugged and kissed them. We shared Bible stories with the children and handed out gifts and Bibles to them. Later, we were served food from the outside kitchen and had a joyous meal together with them. Just prior to our arrival, the angry landlord had locked the doors of the rooms on the second floor and served notice that the children had to be moved to a new facility by June 1st. As we prepared to leave, we promised that, with God's help, we would find a new home for them very soon. As a result of many prayers, a nice home was leased within walking distance of a school, along with a playground. On June 1st, the children moved in, and on June 3rd, they started their new school. To God be the glory!

A testimony from a helpless little girl rescued from a life of poverty and now happily living in Dayspring Children's home My name is Veeroju, age 13 years. I was born in a very poor, remote Indian tribal village. My father deserted us when I was a small child. My mother tried to find work as a daily laborer at a dollar a day. When she didn't find work, we spent many days without proper food and empty stomachs. I was so sad that I couldn't go to school with my friends. I lost all hope until a pastor took pity on me and brought me to Dayspring Children's Home. Now I am so happy. I get lots of love, good food and I am going to school. I love Jesus with all my heart!

IMI begins new building project in Bangladesh The land has been leveled, and Rev. Lawrence informed me that he is ready to begin putting in the footings. So at the end of June, we will be sending at least \$1,000 out of our general fund to help him build this school for educating Christians and reaching out to Muslims and Hindus. Although we hate false religions, we still love the people. Can you help us complete this school? The school will be for all ages, and we will have eighty children attending school and getting fed. To build in **Bangladesh**, mark it on your check and you will get your name and photo on the wall.

Construction projects accomplished so far in 2013

1. We finished a septic system in Honduras.
2. We finished our large boys orphanage in Honduras.
3. We finished a two bedroom house in Honduras
4. We finished a one bedroom house in Honduras.
5. Philippines – We have now built nine pillars for their large gymnasium. So far we have sent \$4,000 and our goal is to raise \$20,000. This building will be used for outreach and feeding the poor. To help out please mark **Philippines** on your check.
6. We have ten-foot cement block walls for our building project on our 16,000 square foot building. Our goal is to get the first floor side walls done so we can put a floor on top of it and then build the second floor. We want to have four stores, one restaurant, a conference room, fifteen hotel rooms and space to start our new church.
7. Our walls are half-finished around the medical clinic with two large gates. We need another \$15,000 to finish the seven-foot walls, then we will put razor wire on top of them to fully secure the clinic.
8. We have moved dirt on our property in Bangladesh to begin building a school.
9. We have almost finished three bathrooms and a shower on our Honduras campus for our workers and our missionaries.
10. We built sidewalks on our compound in Honduras.

Healthy Tip

Avocados are a good source of fiber, potassium, and vitamins C, K, folate, and B6. Half an avocado has 160 calories, 15 grams of heart-healthy unsaturated fat, and only 2 grams saturated fat. One globe contains more than one-third daily value of vitamin C and more than half the daily requirement of vitamin K.

Consider adding avocado or avocado oil to your salads. Recent research shows that antioxidants such as lycopene and beta-carotene are better absorbed with the healthy mono unsaturated fat avocados have in abundance.

To reduce oxidation (browning) of an already-sliced avocado, sprinkle lemon juice on the exposed flesh and then refrigerate in a plastic bag.
