FULFILLING YOUR DESTINY – PART TWELVE

*“...we have redemption through his blood...”*  
Ephesians 1:7

In Leviticus and Hebrews, we are reminded that without the shedding of blood, there can be no remission of sins. And if there is no remission of sins, then we are cursed with all of the curses of Deuteronomy 28:14 through all of chapter 29. Without forgiveness, I have only one destiny, and that is eternal destruction. Despite the fact that many Jewish people through the ages have lived a holier life than the pagan nations around them, the Lord God instructed them in the Old Covenant about the importance of the sacrificial system. # Honduras Highlights

## Report by Dr. Teresa – We rescued three more children...

**two boys and a girl** Angel (8), Dunia (7) and Daniel (4) The mother is very poor and very sick and needs medical attention. Who will help her? The answer is *nobody*. In Honduras, people die because they don't have money to go to the doctor. She needs medical attention now. Can we help? What Jesus would do? We will do our best to take her to the doctor and see if she can get better. The mother was worried her children would die. She asked Delcy, "Please take my children. They will die if they stay with me."

Delcy went to pick them up. What she saw that day was a very sad picture of sacrificial love from a mother who was giving her children away in order for them to have better lives. She hugged her children and cried. Her children hugged her back and said, "I don't want to go. I don't want to leave you, Mama. I love you."

The mother repeatedly said, "I love you, I love you, but you need to go. You will die if you stay with me."

Delcy was crying while seeing that very sad scene. She told the desperate mother, "Don't worry, God is taking control of this situation. Everything is going to be okay. You will not lose your children – you will be able to visit them any time. They will have a better life with us."

Dear friends, our IMI family is growing and that is exciting. Sometimes we feel discouraged when we see a situation like this. We are reminded that what we are doing puts a smile on God's face and the most important thing is to save little children and take care of them. Thank you, Jesus, for the continued flow of Your Spirit and refreshing touch.

**Miracle \$30,000 raised for the playground at IMI's 8th annual conference** In Zechariah, we read about the children playing. We are pleased to announce that Bruce and Deanna Franta from Austin, MN combined with Pastor Kurt Verhoeven from Elkhorn, WI want to buy a huge playground set like those in our parks and schools. We were able to raise the full \$30,000 in thirty minutes as God used Dr. Tim Peterson to motivate people to give. My wife will be picking out the playground equipment and now we are raising money for picnic tables and a basketball court. To give abused children an opportunity to play, mark **playground** on your offering. We have a matching grant, so for every dollar you give, we will have a matching donor.

**Agriculture** The nannies and children are happy eating the corn. We had a tremendous harvest. Thanks be to God for our John Deere (Juan deere) tractor. We raised enough corn off of this harvest to make corn tortillas for a year. Our fruit trees are also growing and we are looking forward to eating our own fruit. The boys help Pastor Oscar with the farming and they are learning to farm. Our two cows are also doing very well. Please keep Pastor Oscar in prayer. Our goal is to be sufficient as far as the food and begin to sell food to our neighbors. To donate to the farm, mark **farm** on your check.



We are in harvest time. The children have been very helpful during harvest. We will have corn for almost the whole year. We are preparing the land to plant beans. The children have planted forty fruit trees. They take the work at the farm seriously.



The windows and doors are almost done for the school, and then we will be ready to move the children to their new classrooms.



We are finishing the last details, like windows and doors, on the kitchen.



**Our goal in one year is to have all of the food supply for our orphanage and church members to be met and to have enough to sell to the community.** We have 36 kinds of fruits, vegetables, grains and meat to raise. Each month we want to knock off three of these, so that in one year we will be growing everything needed to meet our increasing expenses.

**Plant a tree and multiply your giving** A five-dollar tree can produce hundreds or more pieces of fruit each year. If a tree produces for ten years, your five dollars will be multiplied to \$1,000. We can purchase 22 trees per every hundred dollars donated. For a minimum of a hundred dollars, we will put a sign of your favorite person there. We've planted over 400 trees so far.

**IMI's new missionaries** Pray for Jim and Lyn Moomey as they are in Honduras in September. They are from the Milwaukee area and will be joining the staff of our Honduras orphanage. They have an interest in teaching the older orphans job skills as well as developing profit-making projects that will help sustain the orphanage financially. They will return for one month to work with Tom and Teresa in the United States. In October, they plan to permanently make their home in Honduras.

**The City of Refuge is growing** A third family is going to Honduras to build their house. Do you trust the government? Do you want a beautiful vacation home? Do you want a house fully paid off? Another crunch is coming – pray about building in Honduras. It's approximately \$30 a square foot.

### Honduras mission building projects

**School** – The roof and walls are completely finished, and we are now plastering the inside and outside walls. We are hoping to have the school in full operation early this fall. Through the help of Dr. Tim Peterson and our IMI ministers, we raised \$13,000 to finish the school. Now we need to raise the monies to buy the desks and supplies. The school costs total \$88,000 and it is paid off.

**Kitchen** – They are now finishing the small details of the kitchen. We originally were feeding thirty children three years ago. They are now growing up and we have 75 children, plus more than forty workers. It should be done in the next few weeks. The kitchen costs total \$20,000 and it is paid off.



# Around the World

## August was the greatest month of progress ever in IMI

- India – fourteen orphanages added
- India – another orphanage added

## Biggest expansion ever IMI is expanding rapidly, adding fourteen orphanages and 420 full orphans.

Just before we left to go to Liberia, Mercy Smiles – which is run by my spiritual missions parents, Norm and Karen Knudsen – have agreed to hand over their fourteen orphanages with more than 420 children when they graduate to heaven. Despite going very strong, Norm and Karen are in their late 70's and they feel the need to turn over the orphanages to IMI. How cool is this! Karen had a vision 35 years ago that I would go on a mission trip with her husband. 35 years ago this week, I went on my very first mission trip to Colombia. Despite my rebellious attitude that got me lost in the jungle and almost caused Norm and the other missionary to send me home early, God called me into the ministry. Now 35 years later to the week, "mother" Teresa and I agreed to take on the fourteen orphanages. This is the largest venture we have taken on since we first started. Norm and Karen have been in ministry for forty years, and to have them hand over their ministry is not only a huge honor but a humungous responsibility. Our budget just increased dramatically. Our ministry in Honduras has just been surpassed by our ministry in India. Please mark **India** on your check.

## IMI adds 15th orphanage in India through another ministry based in Minneapolis, MN

During our conference, I challenged the people that we would do a matching grant to help orphans in India. Brother Jim and Tara took on the challenge, and together, we are sponsoring another India orphanage with ten beautiful girls rescued from Hindu parents who left them for dead.

**India orphanage prayer request** Please pray for one of our boys at Impact Orphanage who was injured while playing football. The young boy skidded on the ball and two other boys fell on top of him. Barnabas rushed to the home several hours away. The government ambulance took him to the city of Vishakhapatnam several more hours away. His main injury is a badly broken arm with the bones protruding through the skin. Pray for complete healing for him. He was quite frightened, but is okay now.

**Liberia mission trip** Wow! Wow! Wow! There are so many things that happened! I am so blessed.

- #1 Dozens and dozens of people raised their hands for salvation.
- #2 Pastor Steve and I got a chance to preach three times in our Central IMI Church in Monrovia and once in one of our smaller branch churches.
- #3 Dozens of people were healed of tooth, back, stomach and other pains.
- #4 Pastor Steve and I were able to strategize our many building projects that we are getting ready to launch. We will discuss those in this newsletter.
- #5 We spent a lot of time with the Bishop and five of our six pastors in Liberia. They are outstanding men. Wow!
- #6 Five people gave us the deeds to their properties to build churches, orphanages and businesses.



## Interesting Liberia facts

- Liberia was the first free country in Africa
- Ex-American slaves started this nation
- It has been free since 1830, the longest free country in Africa
- Liberia has no electricity because it was bombed during their civil war
- During the civil war that lasted fourteen years, hundreds of thousands of people died and half of their buildings were burned up
- The percentage of born-again Christians is higher than the USA

**Schedule** Thursday, I flew from Rapid City, SD, to Minneapolis and on to JFK in New York City. That evening, I met Pastor Steve Stauffacher, our IMI VP from Madison, WI. We flew out that evening, arriving in Accra Ghana in the morning, and then flew to Monrovia, Liberia. We arrived around 4:00 pm on Friday. We met the IMI welcome team, headed by Bishop Emmanuel Freeman, then went to the hotel, ate supper and went to bed.

Very early on Saturday morning, we went to visit our 100 acres located about an hour from Monrovia. We bought twenty acres and we have a 99-year lease on eighty more. Because of the civil war in Liberia just ending ten years ago, about 10% of the buildings were burnt down and all that is left are walls. We have a 6,000-square-foot building that will be used as a church, school and home for the farm manager. Currently, the rafters are on and they are waiting to put on the tin roof (they call it zinc). We went to our orphanage to briefly meet the children and check out the building projects. The children put on a production and then Pastor Steve and I passed out Bibles, clothes and gifts. That night, we preached at the home church and dozens received Christ. We prayed for healing for fifty people or so.

Sunday morning, Pastor Steve and I preached again, and then, immediately went to our branch church to preach once again. After that service, we immediately went from our branch church back to the main church and taught a one-hour entrepreneur seminar with over fifty people. After that, Pastor Steve and I spent two hours consulting people on their businesses.

Every mission trip has its challenges. Monday morning, the generator was turned off. So I had to do the sponge bath without any lights, but we got 'er done. We went to downtown Monrovia to make sure our tickets were in order. Then we went to the orphanage for three hours where I played soccer and wrestled with the children besides interviewing and loving on them. It was awesome! After that, we had a pastor's meeting for two hours and poured into our ministers. They are wonderful young men, mostly in their mid-twenties.

**Liberia here we come!** Did you know that IMI owns more land in Liberia than anywhere else? 300 acres – but more is coming.

We are officially launching our City of Refuge on 100 acres located one mile from Monrovia the capitol. The roof will be finished on half of our 6,000-square-foot building. Then we will put in windows, doors and bars. After we do the electrical, plaster, refinish the floor and tile, we will send a pastor to launch a church. By the way, there are ten families living on our land, and they are all Muslim. Pray for us.

We had a consultant come and tell us that, based on the vegetation, the land should be good for rubber trees. They have found that natural rubber is better than synthetic. Our goal is to plant 25 acres per year. It will cost about \$500 per acre to plant and weed. To fund one acre, please send \$500 and mark it **rubber trees**. (Just don't send a rubber check that will bounce! Ha, Ha!)

Our lady, named Elanor, who runs the orphanage just gave us her property and her orphanage and school. They have two buildings that are pretty bad. One is where they sleep, and the other is a school. The house is dark and dumpy, kind of like our first orphanage in Honduras. But they have the walls and ceiling done on a two-story 6,000-square-foot building. After I pay the \$2,000 in back taxes, we will begin to finish that building, plus, put a wall around the orphanage.

We are waiting for the paperwork which will turn over a building that was burned during the civil war to IMI for the purpose of building a branch church. We are also waiting for another property to be turned over to us on which we will build an orphanage with a brand new church, and then, we will build them an orphanage. We already have the deed signed over.

In addition to those, we have been offered a piece of property to build another orphanage, and are waiting for that paperwork to be finalized. We are also waiting for the deed to take over a church that has been in existence for ten years and a school that is self-sufficient with over 100 students. We are looking for the right person to farm our 200 acres, located in the jungles of Liberia. Plus, we are looking at buying land to build our IMI headquarters in Monrovia. Pray, pray, pray!

**World-changer tip** If you love the people nobody wants, God will send you the people everybody wants. Dr. Teresa and I have chosen to love the least of these (orphans and widows) and we have seen so much favor in the last month as evidenced by our conference. To see over 150 on-fire ministers come together to learn, worship and grow at our cabin was incredible. Almost everybody that I wanted to be there was able to come and share. If you love those who cannot give back to you, God will send people to help you that you cannot give back to. Be a Boaz, and God will send you a Boaz.

**Miracle at IMI conference-money raised to build a school in Bangladesh** God used Dr. Tim Peterson and IMI ministers and partners to raise enough money to finish our school in Bangladesh. It took six months, but the money is raised, and they are continuing the building process. Pastor Lawrence is overjoyed. Glory to God!

**Testimony** We thank God for some of our best friends, the Rombolds, farmers in Illinois who have sown significant seed into our orphanages. Read this! *"We received a half inch of rain the night you felt led to pray for us! Thank you, thank you."* What do you think the financial harvest was when a half of inch of rain fell on 2,000 acres of corn?

**Do you know** you can rent a beautiful six-bedroom, six-bathroom cabin with large meeting rooms, swimming, fishing, shooting, hunting, volleyball, basketball and games for our cost plus cleaning if you are an IMI partner? Call me if you are interested at (612)202-6064.

**Second time in four months Teresa and I did not take a paycheck** Dr. Tim Peterson encouraged us to give sacrificially to orphans, so we gave up our paycheck the second time in four months. Immediately we were hit with many bills, but God provided. Praise the Lord.

**Do you have a car, truck, snowmobile, furniture, etc. to donate?** Why not feed children with the things you have laying around your property? A good friend of ours donated a truck and we were able to feed 100 children in one month. Call Tom, if you are interested, at (612)202-6064.

## Honduras construction projects accomplished so far in 2013

- Three bathrooms for our workers and missionaries are completed at our city.
- We finished a septic system.
- We set up over twelve to fifteen 40-foot electric poles.
- Our large boys orphanage is completed.
- We finished a two-bedroom house.
- We also finished a one-bedroom house.
- We built a huge shed for our building supplies.

## Construction projects in progress

- The walls around our medical clinic in Honduras are half-finished.
- We now have ten-foot high walls around our retail center in Honduras.
- Our eight-classroom school in Honduras is almost finished.
- The new kitchen building project in Honduras is 95% finished.
- We are building a school in Bangladesh (20% completed).
- We are building a gymnasium in the Philippines (25% completed).
- We built sidewalks for our Honduras compound.
- A roof is being built on one of our churches in Liberia.



## IMI hits the 2.6 million meals mark August 30th

Thanks to God and his people, IMI has paid shipping on 330,000 meals to the Philippines each of the last seven months. To help out mark **food** on your offering check. **Success tip** *Be faithful in small things.* In Zechariah 4:10, we read that the prophet says, "Despise not the day of small beginnings" (NIV and Spanish version say *small things*). I have learned that if you don't tithe on \$10 an hour, you won't tithe on \$100 an hour. If you won't work hard in a little ministry, you won't work hard in a big one. Just seven years ago, Teresa and I started feeding twenty single moms with children for \$100 a month in Honduras. Now, seven years later, we feed 10,000 children and have eighteen orphanages with over 500 orphans. This year will be the first year we give over \$1,000,000 away. Seven years ago, IMI owned one property, and my wife and I had built two houses in our lifetime. By the end of this year, we will have between 30 to 35 houses, buildings, barns, etc. built. But we believe that by the time we die, it will be exponentially bigger. Start small, but believe big!
