WISDOM FROM THE *Word*
FULFILLING YOUR DESTINY – PART 2 I

"Having been predestined to the plan of Him" Ephesians 1:11

Hopefully we know the old adage, if you fail to plan, you plan to fail. I can guarantee failure to those people who don't have a plan. Of course, we understand that those who are led by the Spirit are the Sons of God. Yet, we do need to have a plan. Proverbs 16:3 says, "Commit to the LORD whatever you do, and he will establish your plans." Oftentimes, people ask me how do you keep everything straight. One of the keys is good planning. Here are some keys to planning that have helped me. All of these begin with the letter **P**.

- **Purpose** – Pray about it, meditate, write it out, and put it in a place where you can remind yourself.
- **Put it on paper** – Habakkuk 2:2, "Write the vision and make it plain." All successful people write down their plans or put them into an Excel spreadsheet. Having plans in your head is a sure way to forget them.

Honduras Highlights

Report from Teresa It is a great joy to get things done. Thank you, Jesus, and you dear supporters and partners for helping to get things done. As you know, we are learning to do things God's way, not our way. It is always better that way.

So far, we are working on furnishing the hotel. We have the A/C installed and the water heaters will be installed soon. Mattresses are on their way, and the carpenter is working on the beds. The septic tank will be done this week. The curtains will be made by our missionaries. Also, our dear friends, Bruce and Deanna Franta, paid for a projector and six A/C units for the school.

We'll have a very exciting time this month. I'm leaving to Honduras the 12th of June with two awesome ladies, Laura Diehl and Monica McKeen, from the School of Supernatural Children's Ministry. We are having three days of seminars and TV teaching to prepare and equip the leaders and pastors of Honduras. The 20th of June, we will have nine missionaries from the Rochester, MN Assembly of God buying more cattle for the farm. Then, at the end of the month, 75 missionaries are coming to Honduras, PTL! We have a lot of skilled people who are ready to work and make a difference, so we'll get a lot of things done during this time. We will also do street evangelism and visit the poor, bringing them some food and clothes. We will have a medical crusade, too – fun! fun! The children are all excited to have missionaries come. We will have a great time. Pray for us for protection and to have a blessed and fruitful time there. I will be reporting through Facebook and through our newsletter next month. I love you all.

City of Refuge mentioned on ABC TV Channel 6 in

Rochester, MN On May 11th, one of the largest stations in Minnesota, located in my hometown of Rochester, having a population over 100,000, featured five young men who are riding bikes to 48 continental states (article in more detail found elsewhere). Two of them were saved in our ministry in South Dakota, and they went with my wife to Honduras back in March. They talked about helping our orphanage build a school in the City of Refuge. My wife put the video on her facebook. We can download a copy of the video if you are interested.

Retail center The hotel will be finished the second week of June. We are painting and installing windows, air conditioners and water heaters. The stores and restaurant are finished except for the shelves and restaurant equipment. This has been a three-year project. It is the largest building we have ever built with 9,000 square feet. It includes three stores, one restaurant, offices, ten hotel rooms and a lobby. We praise God for the completion of this building. By this month, we will have bought nine mattresses, beds, furniture, two dryers, two washing machines, desks, towels, curtains, etc. Praise God for His goodness. Come and stay – our hotel is like an AmericInn or better than a Super 8.

Barn report The floor is being poured (first week of June) and then we will putting the walls up. Our farmer, Oscar, is ecstatic.

The gate is finished and it is a beaut!

Girls orphanage In May, we finished the walls, and now the first week of June, we are pouring the floors and working on the roof. The next step will be to do the electricity. The girls are excited about their new home.

Medical clinic We are currently working on the electrical. As soon as it is completed, we will finish the plumbing. Hopefully, we will have it operational late this summer.

Agricultural report We have cleared six acres of weeds, trees and thorn bushes for our sheep and cattle. We just sent \$4,800 to clear eighteen more acres to increase our pasture land. It is the rainy season, and after the land is cleared, we will seed it with grass. We also are purchasing a four-acre guava tree farm which we will be able to use once it is paid off. We are planting 75 more fruit trees this month. Finally, we bought 400 fruit trees and will be planting them this month.

Agriculture in process

- We are building a barn and have raised all of the money. When Rudolfo is finished with the electrical, he will finish the barn for the tractor, implements and grain.
- Phase two of the irrigation is paid for and Oscar will build it after rainy season.
- The corn is growing and we have put weed killer on it.
- We are clearing the upper seventy acres to plant grass for the sheep, cows and goats.
- Our dear friend, Miss Kuriger, has donated enough money to buy six goats.
- We got our sheep back and they are grazing on the land.
- We bought 75 fruit trees which we will be planted in June. This brings our total to 400 trees that are irrigated and will produce fruit.
- We bought another 400 fruit trees to be planted.
- The barn floor is being poured. Then, we will do the walls.

Future agricultural needs

Pigs and pig pens • clearing seventy acres of virgin land to plant fruit trees • another tilapia pond • rabbits and pen • more cows • clear more land for fruit trees and also watermelons • chickens and chicken fencing • turkeys and pens • we are buying sixty acres of agricultural land

Honduras Highlights

IMI made five offers on five properties We chose two properties to start with. We bought a four-acre working fruit farm with a well to irrigate the guava trees. It is a half mile down the main road from the City of Refuge and was being sold for \$40,000. We offered \$30,000. They accepted and we have already made two payments of \$2,500. We have ten payments of \$2,500 left to go. The second property is across the river directly behind our property. It is sixty acres and one-third is irrigated for fruits and vegetables. The other two-thirds is for pasture for our goats, sheep and cattle. This property required \$55,000 down with twelve payments of \$5,000 each. In June, we will be making the \$55,000 down payment, and then, starting our monthly payments.

Invest in land We thank God for our good brother in Wisconsin who invested in Honduras and bought five acres at only \$2,500 per acre. To invest in land in Honduras, it is \$3,000/acre, but if you purchase five or more, it's only \$2,500/acre.

IMI scheduled projects in the City of Refuge

- Barn for our tractor and implements – paid for and being constructed
- Four bathrooms for the school (the bathrooms in the orphanage are too far away, and when the children cannot make it in time, they soil their clothes) – paid for and getting ready to be built
- Storage building for supplies, clothes and toys – we are raising money
- Pulperia (small grocery store) to sell snacks and food – need to raise money
- Church and community center – 15,000 square feet, the largest building we have ever built
- Gasoline station – need to raise money
- High school and tech college – five American students are raising money which we are going to match

Do you like construction? Please consider coming on a mission trip with us. Our building projects have sheetrock, taping, painting and tile work for Americans to do. This gives you an opportunity to finish a project and cut costs for us so we can continue helping those who need it most.

The City of Refuge is growing In June, we are receiving the funds from a fourth family who is going to Honduras to build their house. Do you trust the government? Do you want a beautiful vacation home? Do you want a house fully paid off? Another crunch is coming – pray about building in Honduras. It's approximately \$30 a square foot and some of our small houses are under \$15,000. We are now developing the roads to build your Honduran getaway.

Spiritual quote *"Aim at heaven and you will get earth thrown in. Aim at earth and you will get neither."* – C.S. Lewis Matthew 6:33 says, *"Seek ye first the kingdom of God and his righteousness and all of these things will be added to you."* Our life is a testament of this as we seek first loving God and loving people. I can't tell you how blessed Teresa and I and my family are. In every area of earth we have been blessed. As I focus on heavenly things, God pours out earthly things. I have had people get jealous of how God has blessed us and I will share with you the secret: Live to give, share everything, keep your eyes on the Author and Finisher of our Faith, don't live a selfish life, and you will experience the joys of heaven and earth.

Financial tip *"Under capitalism, man exploits man. Under communism, it's just the opposite."* – John Kenneth Galbraith Capitalism is the best economic system developed by man. But, I believe that the best system developed by God is capitalism with compassion. I like capitalism because it gives an opportunity for people to succeed, and as God gets a hold of our lives, we will be motivated to earn more to give more. Study the Bible. The Old and New Testaments teach us how to prosper so we can help others. Consider Matthew 25 and the three parables. The parable of the wine in the wineskins emphasizes being continuously filled with the Spirit. The parable of the talents says to take our resources, talents, and money and make more. The parable of the sheep and goats encourages us to give to the hungry, thirsty, naked and oppressed. What a perfect teaching of compassionate capitalism!

Mission to China Please pray as I embark on a mission this year. I am sent to China for souls and to open more doors for the Gospel. By teaching ESL, I hope to learn more of the Chinese culture and find links to evangelism. *1 Corinthians 9:19 "For though I be free from all men, yet have I made myself servant unto all, that I might gain the more. And unto the Jews I became as a Jew, that I might gain the Jews; to them that are under the law, as under the law, that I might gain them that are under the law; To them that are without law, as without law, (being not without law to God, but under the law to Christ,) that I might gain them that are without law. To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all men, that I might by all means save some."* – Pastor John

Liberia We now have eight churches, a school and church (four buildings on four lots), and an orphanage with a school with over 25 children. IMI Liberia owns six of the churches and the two schools, the orphanage, plus one hundred acres with buildings on it (rubber trees and other produce that they will be selling), plus another 200 acres with a church and a school with over 100 children. We just paid off the church building in Banga, Liberia. It includes a large sanctuary and three lots to grow crops. We have been having church in Paynesville, Liberia for over a year, and we now have the opportunity to purchase the church building (will need a roof) and a house on one lot. The cost is only \$700.

URGENT – the orphanage girls dorm is waiting to be finished. The walls, roof, electricity and sewer are now completed. We need \$9,000 to finish the bathrooms, doors, windows and tile, and then, the girls can move in. 32 girls are excited about it. They have a horrible building with dirt floors and one light bulb. **PLEASE HELP!** Please mark **Liberia** on your offering check.



Liberia

IMI India Home of Hope is in a small city situated in Chatrapur, Odisha, India around 5 km from the Indian Ocean Bay of Bengal. We had a beautiful campus with hundreds of different kinds of fruit trees and a flower garden, but in 2013, Cyclone Phailin totally destroyed our campus and it has lost all its beauty. But Mercy Smiles International provided us relief funds to reconstruct the boundary wall around the compound and building and to repair many damaged things.

We now have sixty girls and six widows to help the children in the kitchen, do laundry work and clean the rooms and campus. One home manager family is living with them to take proper care of these children. We provide good food, shelter and education. The most important thing is that we are sharing the love of Jesus Christ and making known His good news. Day by day, the children are growing up physically, spiritually and mentally. They are studying in three different schools. Every day they walk to and from school. We do not have our own vehicle to transport them. We also have two teachers who do special tutoring in the home, in the morning and evening. The children did well this past school year. Almost all of them were promoted to the next class. Now, they are in their new classes with new books and notebooks. We provide normal clothing which they use in the home, better dress for going out or to church, and school uniforms. They are very happy when they get a new dress or school uniform.

God has anointed our children with different talents. By the grace of God and your support, they are very happy here. When they think about their past life in their villages and homes compared with their present life in this home, they cannot imagine the love of Jesus Christ and cry with joy, thanking Him for His greatness. They thank God for this great opportunity/provision that He has given them, and they thank you, the sponsors who are helping them. It is great thing that every day, at least two times, they pray for the sponsors. Thanks.

5.8 million meals mark through June 30th Thanks to God and His people, IMI has paid shipping on 330,000 meals to the Philippines each of the last seventeen months. We were able to send a forty-foot container of food to the Philippines through our partner – Risen Savior Missions. Thanks for your generous support in feeding 6,000 children. Drink water throughout the day. Water continuously flushes your digestive system, moving food particles along at a rapid rate, which leads to weight loss. If you are busy drinking your three or four liters of water all day, you won't have the time or desire to drink higher-calorie beverages, like sodas or juice. Don't run to diet sodas to quench your thirst. It is true they have no calories, but diet sodas contain phosphates that rot your teeth and bones as they deplete your calcium, raise your blood pressure, and damage your brain chemistry. They can increase your chance of developing osteoporosis, especially if you are older than forty, because older kidneys are less able to process phosphorus. This can lead to the depletion of calcium, and without calcium, bones will weaken.

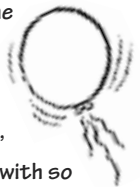
