

Report from Teresa The kids are working on a construction project. They are building a fun playroom and are learning to save money and to tithe. Also, they will earn money for their college education. The girls will work doing chores also and save their money or buy some things they need.

We hired new four new educators; two are in charge of the girls and two male educators are in charge of the boys. That is working well.

Today is a students day. They are having lots of fun activities. Our kids are getting better in their behavior and in school. Keep praying for us. The devil is not liking it that we help children.

Finally, IMI bought thirty agricultural acres We closed on the property in May. We put \$15,000 down and we have payments of \$5,000 for twenty months. This is the best agricultural land. It is flat, black dirt, on the river and bordering one of our properties across the river. In June, we are making a \$20,000 payment. Our goal is to have the land paid off by March, 2017. Praise the Lord!

Missionaries for the month of May Pastor Kurt Verhoeven brought a team of six people from Wisconsin. Kurt comes every other month. Ed came back with him for the fourth time. Their team ministered, hung out with the kids and set up our brand-new pool table. Rev. Joseph and his wife and daughter came to visit for three days. They worked in the largest orphanage in Honduras and they are considering coming and working with us. He is a Bible teacher, is good at fixing things and has many contacts of people who love Honduras. Please pray for the will of God in their lives.

IMI building projects

Omar is adding two more bathrooms to our hotel.

Navoth and his brothers are currently working on bathrooms for the boys and building a very large pantry. They have finished one bathroom and they have two more to go. For the next six months or so, they will be remodeling the boys dorm and adding some more rooms to make it more like a family.

Moises just finished building the goat and sheep barn out of scrap metal. He is currently working on a high fence to separate the school from the orphanage. This will give our children a little bit more privacy and separate their home life from their school life.

Julio finished up the volleyball court. He is putting sinks in the boys bathrooms. He is also redoing the floor of the swimming pool as it has leaks. This time he will be using fiberglass instead of cement. After that he will be putting in swimming pool number two with diving boards. The kids love to dive. This will be a blessing for our Bible camp.

New exciting project – new building for the best behaved kids

There are different ways to motivate good behavior. I prefer the positive ways. We are building a 20 by 75-foot building. Half of it will be for the best behaved children and include music, big screen TV, Xbox and PlayStation, pool tables, refrigerator, snacks, big dollhouses, a Lego area, Lincoln logs, race cars, train sets, etc. We will also have a play place for girls, including building a large dollhouse. In preparation for this building, we bought a small pool table. Normally, I am against Xbox and PlayStation, but if it motivates our kids to obey, work hard, study hard and serve God, it's okay to have a little fun.



This building is unique 1) We are giving one of our good young workers an opportunity to become a contractor. His name is Josue. 2) He is an experienced electrician and welder who is young, positive, energetic and eager to teach the children. He already has trained one of them to weld. 3) This is a wonderful opportunity for our children to learn a number of trades including: cementing, welding, roofing, electrical, plumbing, plastering, and painting. 4) Missionary teams will have the opportunity to build something in Honduras and have a sense of accomplishment. 5) The teens will be able to earn money to buy clothes, games, go out to eat or go to college. This will teach them money management. 6) Our long-term missionaries will be able to broaden their skills. 7) Josue (Joshua in English) and Joshua (Josue in Honduras) will be working together – they will be learning one another's languages and teaching the kids. Volleyball court is almost finished The court is painted and all we are waiting on is the chain-link fence so the kids don't fall off the court and the net. Yay! I love volleyball!!!! We thank God, Dr. Tim Peterson and CFC for donating half the money for the volleyball court.

Special thanks to Mike and Cindy Schupach for donating money to buy toys for the girls I was encouraged by our good friends in Ft. Dodge (Sister Wright) to buy toys for girls. So we did. We have a number of dollhouses, doll clothes, a kitchen set, etc. The kids love it. We also bought a dollhouse for the babies. I get incredible joy seeing the children playing together in the rec center and having so much fun.

In May, we had a baby horse Weee are happy!

We finished building four chicken barns under one roof

The watering system is done, and we just purchased 300 beautiful little chicks. We will be buying 300 chicks every two to three weeks and in three months we will no longer have to buy chickens (just chicks). One day, we hope to have our own hatchery.

The promise of God is being fulfilled As of April, we no longer have to buy eggs, milk, guavas, corn, pigs or fish. Each month, we knock out one type of food that we will no longer have to purchase. Fruit will take the longest as it takes three to five years before they produce.

The wife grew up at a Bible camp and the husband worked at one for ten years. How exciting is that? They say we have all of the recreational activities to get started. All we need is a boys dorm, girls dorm, kitchen, dining room and large meeting room. In July, we will have an engineer design the buildings and off we go. It has been a great month. We had a team of college students here for about three weeks. This group, called Junior Global from Barclay College, worked with us at Gateway Youth Center and at Water Walkers. They helped us in all aspects of our ministry. Their goal was to learn about their major in a practical way while learning a new culture. We were pleased with this group and hope this partnership can continue. God provides great ministry for us. Belize, here we come! We are in the process of buying land in Belize. We are looking for three types of properties:

We have had missionaries in Belize for many years, and we believe that God has put on our hearts to build a City of Refuge in Belize. I have talked to my engineer in Honduras and our best contractor and they want to go and help us get it started. We are so excited! The second property will be a place for people to invest in a house, land and agriculture. It will be a for-profit business, and we are looking for investors and/or people that lean toward being preppers or people that realize that America is going bankrupt and want to get back to the basics. The third will be a retreat center for missionaries, investors and people who want to enjoy the Caribbean at an affordable price.

WISDOM FROM THE *Word*

KING UZZIAH – PART SIXTEEN

“And broke down the walls of Gath...” 2 Chronicles 26:6

Of course, Gath was the capitol of Philistia. Many Bible scholars believe that when Jesus used the word *mammon*, He was referring to one of the Philistine gods. Many translators will translate the words of Jesus equating money with mammon. We will tackle this important topic in the next five newsletters. The Bible is a complete book, therefore at times, scriptures may seem contradictory, but when understood correctly, they are complementary. This topic of finances causes confusion and even division in the body of Christ. Of course, in a small newsletter, I cannot possibly cover every angle. Let me attempt to take both sides of finances in the law, historical books, poetic books, prophets, gospels and the epistles.

The Law

Moses warned us about covetousness with such important emphasis that is listed as one of the Ten Commandments. *Thou shalt not covet!!!* It is wrong to covet anything that is not yours. Covetousness is a thought process that must submit to the will of God. Its close cousins are envy and jealousy. If someone is cursed with a heart of covetousness, envy and jealousy, they are bound by sin and need to be free. If someone manifests one of these triplets toward you, there is only one solution: Be nothing! Accomplish nothing! And own nothing! These three triplets caused the first murder in the first family. Cain was envious of his brother Abel. The Philistines (remember the god mammon) were envious of Isaac. Esau was envious of Jacob. The list of people in the Pentateuch who were blessed financially goes on and on. Obviously it was important or God would not have mentioned it. The anti-prosperity people are at times filled with envy and jealousy or are covetous of those people who are blessed. The facts are: Abraham was ... Isaac was ... Jacob was Joseph was ... financially prosperous. If you choose to be poor, that's up to you, but don't judge those who people are blessed. My experience shows that average people tend to give more than super wealthy to help the poor. However, the big donations almost always come from wealthy people. Simply put, the poor can't help poor people financially because they are poor. Don't covet money, but don't hate it either. Loving your neighbor as yourself was first taught in the law of Moses. But it's hard to love severely poor people when you are broke yourself. Love is more than a feeling; it is an action. When people are hungry, thirsty or naked, feeling bad for them doesn't help them. Next month, we will look at the historical books.

Bioidentical Hormone Therapy

Testosterone in Men

Testosterone is often called "the fountain of youth". This male sex hormone, that stimulates the growth of male characteristics and the production of sperm, is also a precursor of estrogens. It is made primarily in the testes, but is also found, in much smaller amounts, in female ovaries.

The normal levels of testosterone in an average adult male is 270-1,070ng/dl. Low levels can cause various signs and symptoms.

- **Low sex drive:** Testosterone plays a key role in libido (sex drive) in both men and women. Men may experience some decline in sex drive as they age. However, someone with low testosterone will likely experience a more drastic drop in his desire to have sex. Low testosterone can also decrease the sex drive in women, along with other factors, such as other hormonal levels.

- **Difficulty achieving erection:** Testosterone stimulates a man's sex drive. It also aids in erectile function by stimulating receptors in the brain to produce nitric oxide – a molecule that helps trigger an erection. When testosterone levels are too low, a man may have difficulty achieving an erection prior to sex or may experience spontaneous erections (for example, during sleep). Other health problems can influence erectile function, so it is important to determine whether low testosterone is causing this symptom.

- **Low energy and fatigue:** Men with low testosterone have reported extreme fatigue and a noticeable decrease in energy levels. A man might be experiencing symptoms of low testosterone if he is tired all of the time, despite getting plenty of sleep, or if he is finding it harder to get motivated to exercise.

- **Decrease in bone mass:** The thinning of bone mass (osteoporosis) is often thought of as a condition that women experience. However, because testosterone aids in the production and strengthening of bones, men with low levels can also experience bone loss. Men with low testosterone – especially older men who have had low levels for years – are more susceptible to bone fractures.

- **Mood changes:** Women often experience changes in mood during menopause when their estrogen levels drop. Men with low testosterone can experience similar symptoms. Testosterone influences many physical processes in the body. It can also influence mood and mental capacity. Research suggests that men with low testosterone are more likely to experience depression, irritability, or a lack of focus.

Testosterone levels decrease naturally over time, so a man may experience some degree of change in these symptoms as he ages. A doctor can conduct a blood test and recommend treatment if needed. Remember, by taking bioidentical hormones, there is less likelihood of cancer being caused.

He was also interviewed on a network of a hundred radio stations, Fox News and Wisconsin National Public Radio. Please pray for a favorable outcome.
